PENNCREST Students & Families:

On January 26, 2021, all students will return for in person learning Monday – Friday following the [School Board approved 20-21 school calendar](#).

Students in grades 4 – 12 will continue our current hybrid instruction program through January 22, 2021.

- On “A” days (Monday & Wednesday) students with last names A – K in grades 4 – 12 will report to school for in-person learning. Virtual learning will occur on “B” days. Households with multiple last names can choose day “A” or “B”.
- On “B” days (Tuesday & Thursday) students with last names L – Z in grades 4 – 12 will report for in-person learning. Virtual learning will occur on “A” days. Households with multiple last names can choose day “A” or “B”.
- On “C” days (Friday) all students will learn virtually. Every Friday the district will deep clean and disinfect all PENNCREST schools.

Students in grades K – 3, special populations classrooms and CCCTC students will begin Monday – Thursday in-person instruction on Monday, January 11, 2021.

- On **both** “A & B” days (Monday through Thursday) K – 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students and special population classrooms will report for in-person learning.
- Crawford County Career and Technical Center students may attend the CTC on “A” and “B” days (Monday through Thursday) but only attend his or her high school on the designated A or B day. Each high school will provide information regarding transportation modifications.

Depending on current data and COVID-19 transmission trends, we may permit after school extracurricular activities and additional use of school facility in early February. Your continued patience and cooperation are appreciated. If you have questions or concerns, please contact the building principal.
