### Enrollment

- Currently we have 2558 students. 1938 will be in person and 620 will be virtual. (76% In person).

### Schedule Changes this semester

- This semester the counselors were able to create all in person section for teachers and a few all virtual as well.
- Many students' schedules were edited to help both students and teachers. Thanks for everyone's support.

### Asynchronous days

- February 10 and April 21 will be remote learning/asynchronous days from home for all high school students.
- Students will be expected to continue their coursework online at home. Teachers will post assignments for the day in itsLearning, and students will submit coursework for each class period. Parents may request for students to be on campus on these days.

### SAT School Day- Juniors only

- March 3<sup>rd</sup> is the College Board "School Day SAT" for all Junior-level students.
- Juniors will report to campus as College Board exams are not remotely proctored. Distance learners who wish to take this exam will report to school. Health and safety protocols, as outlined in LearnSBISD, will be followed, including face mask requirements and social distancing.

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- 9th, 10th and 12th grade students will remain at home for a remote learning/asynchronous day. This day will mirror the fall administration of College Board exams.

## **Spring 2021 Semester Exams**

- We will have early release days for high school students on May 25-26-27.
- We have restored exam exemptions for high school students for Spring 2021 semester exams.
- Semester exams will continue to be administered on-campus. Exam schedule will be posted soon.
