Risk Assessments

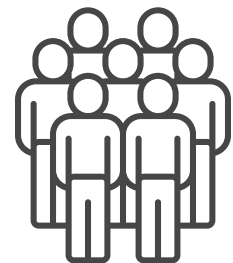
Syntero clinicians can administer risk assessments to assess for any imminent danger that a student may pose to themselves and/or others. The clinician will share the findings/recommendations with the school and the student's parent/guardian.

Please note that Syntero clinicians are unable to predict long-term risk of harm to self/others.

SOS

Signs of Suicide Program Support

Syntero clinicians are available during Signs of Suicide programming to provide support with screening student responses and triaging students in crisis following the HelpLine SOS presentation. The clinician will provide these services based on the schedule determined by the school and HelpLine.



Community Crisis Response Team

Syntero provides assistance following traumatic events that influence our schools and surrounding communities. Examples of potential responses include but are not limited to:

- Death of a student or staff member
- Attempted suicide
- Community violence
