PSD In-Person Learning Update for 2nd Grade

Dear Peninsula School District 2nd Grade Families,

We recently received guidance from the Governor's Office which allows for more students to return for in-person learning. In addition, our December COVID-19 testing pilot demonstrated that when safety countermeasures are followed, we can control virus spread on campus while in-person learning is occurring. Approximately 1,700 students and staff were tested over three weeks in December and there were no instances of virus spread on any of our elementary campuses. Thus, we believe the successful implementation of our current safety protocols, combined with the new state guidance, will allow us to expand our elementary in-person learning opportunities to more students.

On Tuesday, January 19, 2nd grade students and families who selected in-person learning are invited back to our elementary campuses. Those choosing to learn remotely can continue to do so.

Since we were prepared for the return of our 2nd graders in November, those students who needed to be reassigned to a different teacher may already know about that reassignment. Our schools will finalize all reassignments in the coming days and will share information with you very soon.

Like our Kindergarten and 1st grade students, 2nd graders participating in in-person learning will attend school on campus four days a week, and continue with remote learning on Wednesdays.

Students who need transportation can ride the same bus as Kindergarten and 1st grade students who are coming to school for in-person learning. You can find bus routes and times [here](#).
