Oregon Chafee Education and Training Grant

To help current or former **foster care youth** access posthigh school education and training.

To be eligible, you must:

- Currently be in child welfare foster care, or
- Had been in child welfare foster care for at least 180 days (six months) after your 14th birthday and exited substitute care at age 16 or older, or
- **NEW**: Be a former foster youth who was adopted or entered into a guardianship on or after your 13th birthday, and your adoption/guardianship finalized after **9/1/2015**.
- **NEW**: Final disbursement will not exceed the term before the youth turns age **26**.
- NEW: Students can receive the ETG for a maximum number of 5 years.






