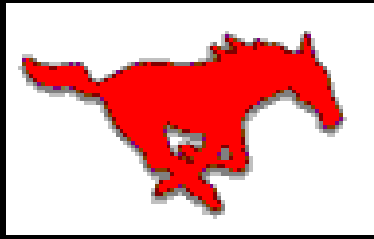

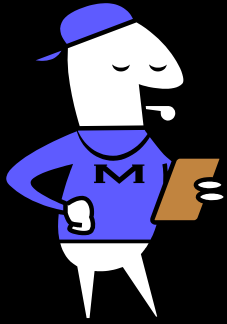

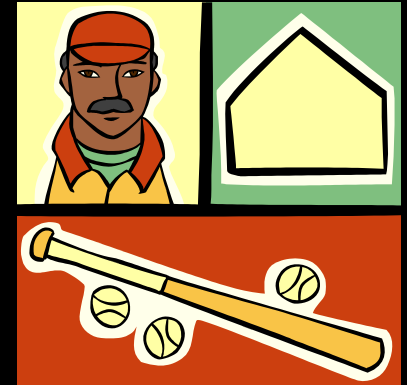
Memorial Baseball Last 15 Years

Objective Grading

- 60 Time
- Pro Agility Time
- Arm Strength (Radar Gun MPH)
- Bat Speed (Bat Speed Machine)
- Ball Exit Speed (MPH) Off Tee
- Broad Jump



Subjective Grading

- Fielding (1 to 5 Scale)
mechanics; footwork; hands
- Hitting (1 to 5 Scale)
mechanics; solid contact; approach
- Intangibles: Hustle, coach ability, attitude
- Projectability

- Command
- Mechanics
- Arm Strength
- Projectability



Catchers

- Foot work
- Receiving Skills
- Arm Strength
- Pop to Pop time

TOP 10 H.S. TRYOUT TIPS

10. **DON'T SHOW UP COLD** Get in the cages at least 1 month prior to tryouts
9. **TRY OUT AT YOUR BEST POSITION**
You can show off your other skills later
8. **DRESS THE PART** Baseball pants, belt, cleats/spikes, hat on straight
7. **BE AGGRESSIVE!** Take hacks, dive for balls. Extra effort gets noticed
6. **WARM UP WITH PURPOSE**
Lazy catch impresses no one
5. **COMMUNICATE WITH YOUR COACHES** You, not your parents
4. **BE PREPARED** Know your coach's style, his likes and dislikes
3. **DON'T BE A GRADE RISK**
No pass, no play. Coaches will check
2. **HUSTLE EVERYWHERE** There's no excuse to walk any where, any time
1. **SAY THANK YOU** Shake coach's hand after tryouts, look him in the eye
