## Community

Located 38 miles northwest of Chicago, Lake Zurich Community Unit School District 95 comprises an area of 19.4 square miles, which includes the communities of Lake Zurich, Deer Park, Hawthorn Woods, portions of Kildeer, Barrington and unincorporated areas such as Forest Lake and Echo Lake.

Enrollment is just under 1,800 students with 457 students in the senior class.

## Extra Curricular Activities
