Maths

This week we will begin to explore addition and subtraction to 20. We will be using a number line to add and will use a part whole model to look at number bonds to 20.

Learning Journey: This week, in History, we will be exploring why messenger pigeons were so important during the First World War. As part of this, the children will consider how the forms of communication in the present day were not available in the First World War, so they had to communicate differently.

English

This week we will be continuing to look at our new key text 'The Jolly Postman'. We will be writing a letter from Baby Bear to Goldilocks and thinking about whether or not Baby Bear should forgive her.

Sounds Write

This week we will continue looking at the extended code.

We will begin to explore the /ow/ sound and the different ways to spell the sound; ow and ou.

Please could you practice the following words based on our phonics this week. Look at the spellings with the 'ow' sound (ow & ou).

Shout, brown, cloud, tower, loud, town, count, down. Can you think of other words with this sound?



Reading at Home
