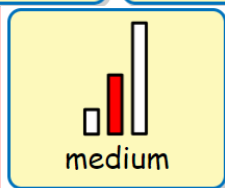
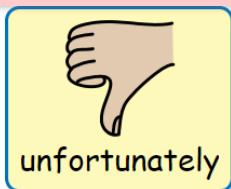
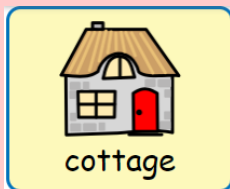
Thank you for your patience and effort with the new remote learning last week. This is a challenging time for everyone so well done to all.
