If you are having difficulties getting going, please contact us- our telephones are operational this time around between 9am and 3.30pm.

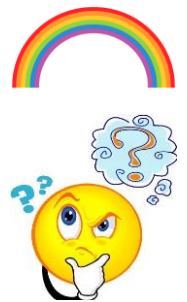
## DON'T FORGET YOUR FOOD HAMPER
