- Applications will be processed as quickly as possible. Families will be notified of their acceptance into the district. Discipline records will be reviewed; students who have been suspended in the last two years may not be accepted as a Schools of Choice student.
- Applications will be accepted from January 11, 2021, through 4:00 pm on January 22, 2021.
- We have openings in all grade levels except Kindergarten, first and eighth grade.
