Hello Sparks families, my name is Marianny Santana, and I am the Special Education Manager for NCE. I have had the great opportunity of meeting many of our families and students! I want to remind families that if you have any questions regarding supports for your student here at NCE, please reach out to me via email, and we can schedule a time to speak based on your concerns. Our special education program helps ALL students succeed here at NCE, from Speech therapy to academic support. My email address is Marianny.Santana@yesprep.org. I wanted to share with our families who have requested testing. Once you sign the consent and return it to me, the school evaluation team has 45 school days to complete the evaluation. If the student is virtual, we will schedule a time for you to bring the student to campus for us to be able to complete the evaluation. Once it is completed, we will hold a meeting to determine the evaluation's findings and determine if supports are needed 😊.
