2021-22 Wiseburn Preschool
Enrichment Program

Dear Prospective Parents/Guardians:

The Wiseburn Unified School District operates a Preschool Enrichment Program for “Preschool” children ages 3-5. A web-based student application system (<https://wiseburn.schoolmint.net>) has been developed to assist with enrollment, district-wide tracking of open seats, and wait list priorities. The Wiseburn community has growing needs for a preschool program and, as a result, application and enrollment priorities have been identified to address these needs.

For the 2021-22 school year, admission priorities will be as follows:

Wiseburn Preschool Enrichment Program Returning Students ~ January 15-January 22, 2021

Families of students currently enrolled in the Wiseburn Preschool Enrichment Program, and their incoming siblings, will be given a priority window of January 15-22, 2021 to re-register for the 2021-22 Wiseburn Preschool Enrichment Program.

Wiseburn Resident ‘New’ Students ~ January 25-January 29, 2021

Wiseburn residents new to the preschool program will be given a priority application window of January 25-29, 2021

Other Interested Families ~ February 1, 2021

Preschool open enrollment for other interested families will begin on February 1, 2021 and will be ongoing.

TK & Kindergarten Extended Day Program

Enrollment in the Wiseburn Preschool Enrichment Program **does not** automatically secure a space in the **Transitional Kindergarten/Kindergarten Extended Day Program**. Parents with students currently enrolled in the Wiseburn Preschool Enrichment Program **who will transition their student to the TK/kindergarten extended day program**, will need to access the application process based on the above stated admission priority windows.

Although the Wiseburn Preschool Enrichment Program is not a required district program and is a separate fee-based parent funded program offered on the Wiseburn campuses, the district has responded to the community need and is doing its best to accommodate as many students as possible. Mark your calendars to ensure that you are accessing the web-based portal (<https://wiseburn.schoolmint.net>) during these important enrollment windows.
