3. ForeFront Suicide Awareness Parent Meeting - RESCHEDULED - Mark Your Calendars

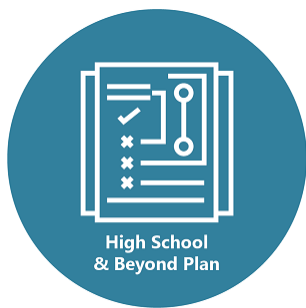

7. Emergency Preparedness

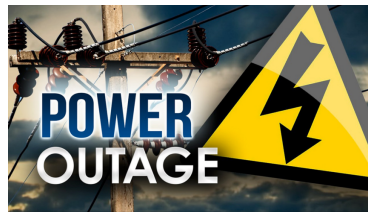
It's that time of year when things get a little stormy outside. We start to get wind, rain, and lightning. All of this can lead to some unsafe situations and power outages. Here are some ways to be ready.

When lightning strikes:

- Stay indoors or head indoors if you can
