Where we are today

- On Dec. 30, Governor Newsom announced that schools may apply for waivers to resume in-person learning in the **elementary grades** while in the purple/widespread tier.
- However, no specific announcement or update has been given for high schools.
- The Governor shared that California's phased approach to returning to in-person learning will begin with grades K-6, special education and populations disproportionately impacted by COVID-19.

Where we are today

- While Governor Newsom announced that the State is looking to support all communities to be on track for safe in-person instruction by early Spring 2021, this plan is in its initial stages and will need to be worked through with the California Legislature.
- This process will likely take several weeks, and there is currently no date for finalizing this plan and no date for the first phase of returning California's schools to in-person instruction.
- Much of the Governor's plan depends on the continued rollout and availability of the vaccine. We know that school staff are being prioritized for vaccination at the state level, and we are looking forward to receiving more information about how that process will unfold, but we don't know if or how how schools/districts may be involved in this process.

Academic Supports

- Staff will be examining the results of the semester grades to see what strategies and interventions are needed to address the needs of those students that are struggling
- Ensuring that students are ready for the next course in a sequence and prepared for college

Mental Health Supports

- Students continue to face challenges in terms of mental health and social isolation
- We continue to use the Mental Health & Wellness Check-In process –
 information on the district Distance Learning webpage, as well as the
 Student Wellness & Resources webpages on each school website
- Partnership with Care Solace to help families and staff locate mental health services, with positive feedback from those families that have used these services
- Advisory lessons on coping with stress and challenges of distance learning

- For many years the District has required a stringent residency verification process for all incoming 9th Gr. and current 10th Gr. Students.
- This year, due to the Pandemic, the entire Residency Verification process has moved to a digital platform.
- Instead of coming to the school at designated times and providing residency documents in person, parents are now completing an on-line form using Informed K12.

Parents first complete some basic information about themselves and their student, as well as verify that they have completed the normal online registration requirements (Incoming 9th Gr. Only).

- Current paystub employer & employee's name & address must be printed on paystub


3. Residency Document #2 - check and attach one of the following:

- Most recent Property Tax Bill with parent name & property address, not payment stub
- Tenant's copy of Rental or Lease agreement with parent name & address with manager or owner's name and phone number (usually the first page and the signature page)



- Once the form is completed and the required documents attached, parents digitally sign and submit the form.
- Once submitted, the encrypted form is sent to the school sites electronically where each of the documents is reviewed by confidential school employees.
- All approved forms and accompanying documents are stored electronically and protected for confidentiality. Each time the documents are accessed, a digital log is created to document the date, time and length of access as well as who accessed it

- Emails providing instructions and link to form have already been sent to all incoming 8th Grade Students in CUSD and SSD, as well as all current 10th Gr. Students attending a District School.
- Residency Verification must be completed by Jan. 29 for all students.
