**Enrollment Fee (community).** This required annual fee places the student on the SAS roster. It is due upon enrollment and **non-refundable** once billed or paid. The enrollment fee is not a deposit on, nor a prepayment of, tuition.

**Annual Tuition**

- May be paid in full by June 1 with a 2% discount if paid by check, cash or bank bill pay (ACH payment does not apply; offer expires June 2).
- May be paid in full by June 1 by credit card or wire transfer (no discount, no credit card or wire fees; fees apply beginning June 2).
- May be paid in 10 monthly installments beginning June 1, 2021 and ending March 1, 2022 by ACH (a direct debit from your bank account). Completed ACH Authorization is required to initiate these payments.

**Payment Terms**

- Payments are due by the 1st of the month; payments via ACH will occur on the 5th of the month.
- Account balances that are paid by the 5th of the month will avoid late fees.
- Account balances paid between the 6th and 20th will be subject to a \$15 late fee.
- All payments made after the 20th of the month will be subject to an additional \$50 late fee.
- Any payment that is returned for any reason will be subject to a \$25 fee.
- Credit card payments will be subject to a 3% convenience fee (Does not apply to enrollment fees).
- Students may not participate in the SAS program beginning the first day of the following month if the previous month's balance is not paid.
- Missed sessions are not reimbursed.

**SAS Program Commitment.** Parents/guardians will agree and affirm during online enrollment or reenrollment:

- Affirm understanding that the Educational Therapy is not a quick solution to the learning difficulty of the student.
- Affirm understanding of the program's goal for the student and belief in its basic philosophy.
- Agree that continuing with SAS Educational Therapy participation is a commitment to the education of the student.
- Agree that if participation in SAS Educational Therapy is a condition of the student's enrollment at Bellevue Christian School, the student must remain enrolled in the SAS program in order to be an enrolled student at the school. (If in doubt whether your student's SAS enrollment is a condition of school enrollment, contact the SAS director to confirm.)
- Affirm understanding that for the student to reach the goals described in the therapy program it may take a minimum of two to three years or more, depending on the learning needs of the student.
- Affirm understanding that the student will receive SAS testing at the end of the school year and that the student's therapist and/or the SAS director will communicate the test results to parent/guardian, at which time an updated academic plan will be determined for the following school year.
- I/we understand and agree that responsibility to pay tuition is not based on my/our student's academic success.

**Force Majeure.** In the event of school closure beyond the school's control, the School's duties and obligations will be postponed until such time as the School, in its sole discretion, may safely reopen and/or comply with its duties and obligations. A full description is provided in the online enrollment process.

**Withdrawals.** Because BCS makes employment commitments to therapists and orders supplies based on the student's participation in this program, parents/guardians agree to tuition responsibility equal to the June 1 installment through January 1 installment (end of 1<sup>st</sup> semester. After completing the first semester, and regardless of the number of sessions attended in the second semester or the date of withdrawal, I/we will be charged through the end of the final month attended. Unless modified or cancelled in writing after end-of-year testing, parents/guardians will contract to pay for student's participation in the established number of SAS sessions, understanding that the SAS tuition, June through January, is due once billed and is non-refundable, and beginning February 1, this contract follows the BCS withdrawal policy.

February 1 to end of school year	Tuition responsibility is for the total contracted program. No proration of month.

**Standards of Conduct and Tuition Responsibility.** Student and parents or guardians will be required to affirm understanding of and agreement with the parent/student handbook in its current version as found on the BCS website. If student leaves or is asked to leave BCS or the SAS program for reasons including but not limited to behavioral, academic, or social, or due to the conduct of the parent or guardian, or due to non-payment of tuition for whatever reason, parent/guardian will remain responsible for the SAS tuition subject to the above withdrawal policy. (Official transcripts and student records are provided only when tuition responsibility is paid.)
