Located next to Celia Clinton Elementary School, this facility will serve 164 children and their families from 6 weeks through four years old.

TWO-WAY DUAL LANGUAGE PROGRAM

Celia Clinton Elementary is the first neighborhood school to offer a two-way dual language program. Beginning in Pre-K or kindergarten, students in the program speak two different native languages and receive instruction in both English and Spanish.

Bilingual children who are educated in their second language have been seen to outperform single language children in their native language. Bilingualism also increases brain cognition by utilizing the highest levels of thinking, focus, and awareness.

PROGRAMS AND CLUBS

Together we will offer Project-Based Learning (PBL) tutorials two days a week and a four week Project-Based Learning time during the summer.
