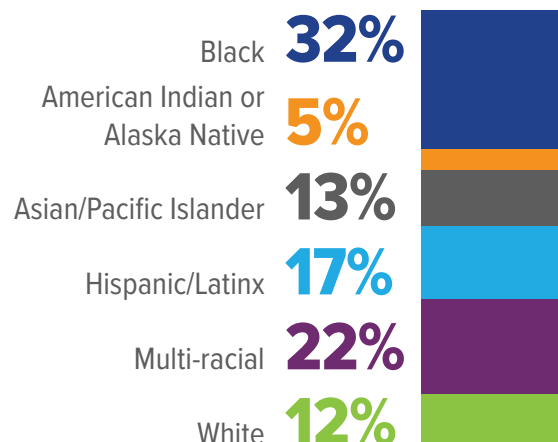
FOCUS ON THE WHOLE CHILD

At Eugene Field Elementary, we greatly value parent and community engagement! As a result, we schedule various parent appreciation events throughout the year to celebrate parents.
