

# **BOYS' BASKETBALL COVID-19 PROTOCOLS**

## **GAMES:**

- Stay home if you or a family member are not feeling well or showing symptoms. Text your coach if you will not be making it.
- Players are encouraged to transport themselves to away games.
- Carpooling is discouraged. If you must carpool, keep it to one or at most 2 other families and wear masks in the car. Keep any carpool groups consistent with the same group.
- A bus will be provided for those 9<sup>th</sup> grade and B/JV players who need transportation from SLPHS to and from away games.
- 9<sup>th</sup> grade, B-squad, and JV players should plan on arriving to the game venue a half hour before game time dressed in uniforms and ready to play. Locker room access will be limited.
- Varsity players should arrive to home games at 6:00 and away games at 6:15 dressed and ready to play.
- Masks must be worn the entire time in the schools, which includes during games. We will provide disposable surgical masks for all players on game day. Extra masks will be available in the bench area during games. (Players can bring extra, back up masks as well.)
- Bring your own water bottle, sweat towel, and bag for your gear each game.
- Use hand sanitizer before, during, and after the game.
- Do not linger in groups before or after games. 9A, 9B, and B-squad players will have to leave the venue right after their games. Buses for the 9<sup>th</sup> grade and B/JV will leave away venues right after their games. JV players will be allowed to stay and watch the varsity games at home in the south bleachers socially distanced and masked. JV players will have to leave away venues right after the JV game.

- Each player will be allowed 2 family members to attend games. They will need to be on the attendance list by 11:00 am on game day. The Rebounders Booster Club will be contacting families to be included on the list.
- Games will be live streamed as well. Mr. Wackman will get out the info on the links for live streaming.
