

Transcript Review

Transcript Review

- ▶ Your transcript is divided by semester for each year .
- ▶ Pay attention to the class and the grade
- ▶ If you are a new student who enrolled at the beginning of the year/semester, your transcript may not have been evaluated yet. Don't be alarmed, but you will have to use your memory to do your credit check
- ▶ If you are a new student from another country, your grades were transcribed as "P" for pass

Transcript Review

- ▶ Notice “WA HIST REQ MET” – This is listed at the end of your transcript under “ADDITIONAL STATE REQUIREMENTS.” You should have completed this class in 8th grade and while you don’t get numerical credit for it, it does satisfy the state requirement
- ▶ "HIGH SCHOOL AND BEYOND PLAN" are your Xello assignments that you are completing each year. This will not be marked at "MET" until Spring of your Senior year, once all assignments have been marked complete.

Credit Check

- Each graduating class requires 24 credits to graduate
- Use your transcript to complete your credit check form

Credit Check

- ▶ Each box equals one semester or .5 credit
- ▶ There are an appropriate number of boxes for each subject area you need
- ▶ For each semester class you have passed, cross out one box next to the corresponding subject
- ▶ If all the boxes next to a required subject area are checked off, and you have completed an additional class, it will count as elective credit
- ▶ Circle the classes you are currently enrolled in this semester

Course Catalog

- ▶ Our Course Catalog is available online on the LWHS website
- ▶ Courses are listed by department
- ▶ Please review the academic policies, especially the Student Initiated Schedule Changes on page 6
- ▶ Minimum college entrance requirements are explained on pages A7 and A8 at the back of the catalog
- ▶ WANIC information is on page A6
- ▶ Please note course code, course grade levels, dual-credits options, prerequisites, lab fees, homework and length of course (semester or year)

Registration Request Form

(Optional, for your use only! Will not turn in)

- ▶ Select classes for the entire year. You should have 14 semesters total (7 full-year classes)
- ▶ Required core courses are filled in
 - ▶ You can choose between regular, Honors, or AP levels
- ▶ If necessary, write in your correct course level with the course code
- ▶ Choose remaining elective classes by using your credit check form
 - ▶ On the back of your registration form is a list of elective classes that your graduating class is eligible to request
 - ▶ Be sure to write down the course code (that is how you will enter your choices online)
- ▶ **Select 3 alternate electives. These are your back-ups if one of your first-choice classes becomes full.**
- ▶ **If you have failed a required class**, you need to see your counselor to create a plan for credit retrieval and timely graduation

Advanced Courses

- ▶ While it's a good idea to challenge yourself with accelerated courses like Honors or Advanced Placement, think very carefully about these **year-long** commitments . . .
 - ▶ Talk to teachers
 - ▶ Find out how much homework and outside of class reading is required; consider the pace, the rigor and time commitment
 - ▶ Evaluate your other activities (clubs, athletics, family, work, volunteering, spiritual, etc.)
 - ▶ If you move from an advanced level class to a regular level class after the semester drop deadline, a "W" will be posted on your transcript

Running Start

- ▶ Still graduate with your class from LWHS
- ▶ Could get your AA degree while in high school
- ▶ Earn both HS and college credit
- ▶ Must place into Math/English
- ▶ Informational meetings on February 26th and March 5th during Homeroom 10-10:30am.

WANIC

- ▶ Still graduate with your class from LWHS
- ▶ Partial schedule at LW and Skills Center
- ▶ Earn both HS and college credit
- ▶ Great for job prep in specific fields

Reminders!

- ▶ Based on requests from students, we create classes and teacher assignments. **Think very carefully about your selections!** Talk to your teachers and parents
- ▶ Remember, if you are placed in a class you requested, **you are expected** to stay in the class
- ▶ It is always difficult to change your schedule in the fall and depends on space availability
- ▶ The classes you choose during registration are considered final. We cannot make changes to your requests, so take your time and choose carefully.

Registration Dates

- ▶ **All students:** Online registration opens during Homeroom on *Friday, January 15th- Friday, January 22nd*, and closes at the end of Homeroom on the 22nd.
- ▶ Registration is not first come first served, so please be mindful of your selections and be sure to register during this week timeframe.

Online Registration Directions:

1. Internet Explorer (Not Google Chrome) – www.lwsd.org
2. Click on **Student Portal** link on the right and log in
3. Click on **Student Access** link on right side of page
4. Click “OK” if a dialog box pops up
5. Click on “**Schedule**” button on the left side of page
6. Click on “**View Available Courses 2020-2021**” link (top right of page) and maximize screen
7. Your required courses are pre-populated for you
 - If the incorrect class is showing, add the correct class using the class code (listed alphabetically by code); data processing will delete the incorrect pre-populated course
8. Click on the course you are requesting from the **Available Courses** on the left side and choose **Add Course** to move the course to the **Selected Courses** on the right side.
9. To remove a course, click on the course in the right box and click, **Remove Course**.
10. Don't forget to **enter your 3 alternate electives** under the **Request Alternates** tab

You should have 7.0 credits requested plus 3 alternates.

When finished, use the top right x icon to exit the screen, and **LOGOUT!**
