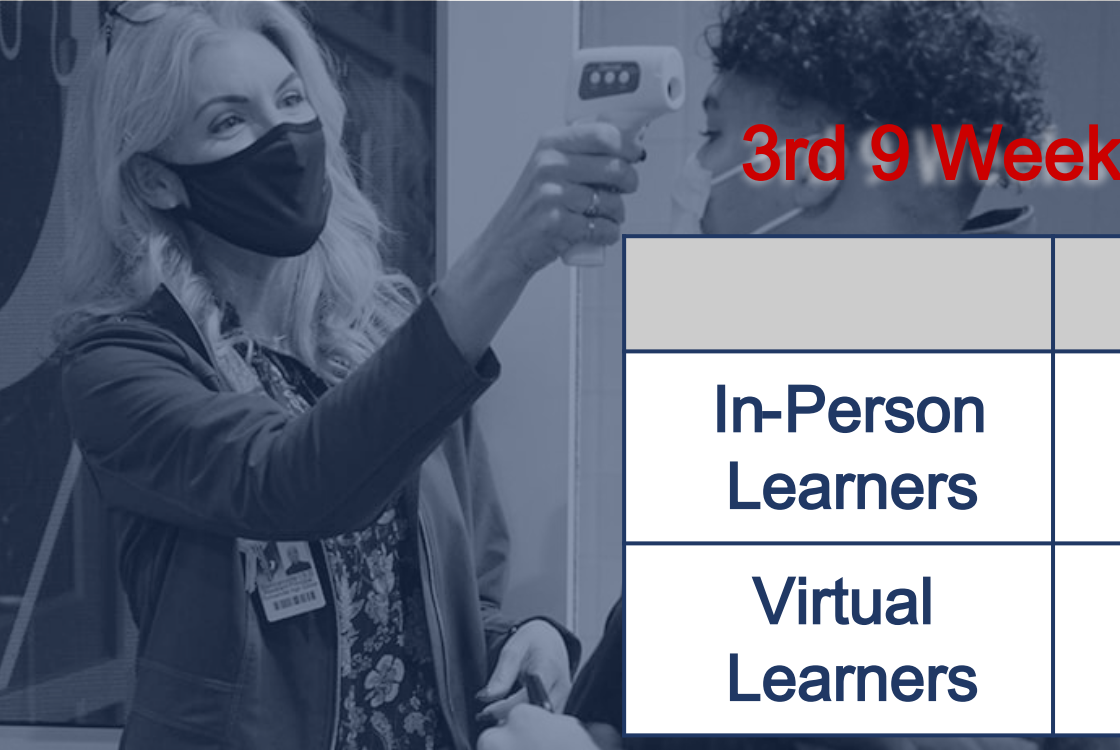

Amount Qualified:

- 7,840 monthly tests
- 7,840 N95 masks
- 9,800 surgical masks
- 19,000 surgical gloves
- 1,960 protective gowns
- 588 bottles of hand sanitizer
- 1,960 face shields

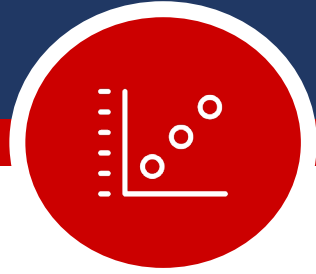

Supporting Student Engagement

Operation Connection

Connect:

- With families and students who are enrolled as virtual students, but not engaged in the learning.

Inform

- Provide families with quick reference guides for how to access technology applications.
- Important dates for parents (Method of Instruction change date, etc.,)
- Community available resources for families (food banks, counseling, etc.,)
- Small district calendar on one side with all of the district campuses' contact information on the back.

Support

- District counseling services information
- Quick Reference Checklist of 3 to 5 reminders a parent can ask their child daily to verify or check for engagement

Curriculum and Training Support



- Increased standards training and support through specifically designed videos with a curriculum focus
- Professional learning communities will utilize video sessions for lesson design on high frequency standards
- February 15 District Staff Development
- Special program support for training on learning accommodations, as well as intervention sessions to support diverse learning needs

Summer Intervention Program



- Preliminary planning underway for instructional design
- Summer Program will be offered for students who have failed for grades and/or attendance
- Summer Support Programming will be offered for students who meet criteria
- Early Childhood Summer Program will support PK and K students
- Extended School Year for Special Education Students
- Advanced Academics, Dual Credit, and Career Technology Programming

Calendar AdjustmentAdditional Days



- The current 2020-2021 academic calendar has 168 student instruction days (the minimum required)
- Proposed 2021-2022 academic calendars all provided 12 additional days for a total of 180 student instruction days
- Additional instruction time provides more opportunity for increased student engagement
- Teachers will continue to work 187 days, but they will have more days with students.
