	<p>Gulf State (Frommer speaking) couldn't donate one, but school couldn't/wouldn't get commitment signed</p> <p>Sumners says it's been signed now; working with Robert and Tony to have the ceremony to receive the car.</p>	
	<p>Program continues to have good enrollment</p> <p>Intro class (split between auto tech and auto body) – 80 total students</p> <p>Auto 1 (nonDC) 39</p> <p>Auto 2 (nonDC) – 12 (10 seniors)</p> <p>Auto 1 ECHS (DC) – 35</p> <p>Auto 2 DC – 18 (majority seniors)</p> <p>Graduating 35 seniors this year</p> <p>Attrition rate – 15 students.</p> <p>ASE Certifications – normally test in Spring for entry and 609 students.</p> <p>Last year, tested all double blocked students.</p> <p>Missed the window for this year.</p> <p>Will test next year.</p>	

	<p>Entry level tests (not professional) – secured and purchased testing credits – don’t normally roll over - ~\$4000 hit if not rolled over.</p> <p>Goal to get back to business as usual next year (assuming we have the ability to do so)</p> <p>P-TECH Program – only Auto Tech program in state with Program 3 years at SGHS, 1 year at Eastfield. Automotive will move from ECHS to P-TECH</p> <p>We’ve recruited well for Auto-Tech – 24 students enrolled now for next year.</p> <p>We’ve had virtual meetings Working on enrollment packets and admissions application with Eastfield.</p> <p>Freshman 1305 & 1307 Sophomore year 1310, 1316 Junior Year 1345, 2328 Senior Year – 8 classes to finish degree</p>	
	<p>Recapping the meeting last night – Talk of next year 10 students on A day, 10 on B day – went to Toyota Dealership</p>	

	<p>Wearing N95 mask, face shield, gloves, long sleeve shirts w/ Clorox Total 360 system</p> <p>Frommer – industry from GST- 3000 technicians at 158 dealership – currently 2800 are still employed – Early April was the bottom of the labor hours; every week there has been an increase in technician hours. Things are improving! PPE – helter-skelter – No one is an expert, so most everyone is isolated in what they’re doing, interpreting CDC guidelines on their own. Developed 57 page manual of how to interact with customers and handle vehicles – widespread manual w/local managers making final protocols. Frommer will share document (manual) with us not as a recommendation, but just a baseline. Has a guide for what cleaning supplies to use on cars.</p> <p>Strong – where students are parking and entering the school have to sign waivers and doing wellness checks; suggested that students come in by the back door rather than the hallway – Bellamy asks how big area is and how many students they have – Strong to find out more at 1 today</p>
