



# Daily Symptom Attestation



**Have you had close contact (within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes) in the last 14 days with someone diagnosed with COVID-19, or has any health department or health care provider been in contact with you and advised you to quarantine?**

- Yes - The person should not be at school. The person can return 14 days after the last time they had close contact with someone with COVID-19, or as listed below.
- No - The person can be at school if they are not experiencing symptoms.

**Since you were last at school, have you had any of these symptoms?**

- Fever
- Chills
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- New cough
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat, new congestion or runny nose

- Yes - If a person, or anyone in their household, has any of these symptoms, they should go home, stay away from other people, and call their health care provider.
- No - The person can be at school if they are not experiencing symptoms.

**Since you were last at school, have you been diagnosed with COVID-19?**

- Yes - If a person is diagnosed with COVID-19 based on a test, their symptoms, or does not get a COVID-19 test but has had symptoms, they should not be at school and should stay at home.
- No - The person can be at school if they are not experiencing symptoms.
