- Students to be scheduled into all periods ("free blocks" and afternoon options)
- Optional early departure times
- Dedicated Community,
 Social-Emotional, and DEI times

COHORT GROUP LEARNERS Daily Routines



- Mondays Distance learning everyone

- Tue/Wed or Thur/Fri
 - Arrival 7:45 8:00 AM
 - All US students at US Entrance in masks from vehicle departure
 - Health App Check
 - Westview Lunch Tickets available
 - Proceed directly to first class location
 - Optional late arrival for students with early "free blocks"





- Tue/Wed or Thur/Fri
 - Classes
 - Seating limited to spaces by 6ft/3M distance
 - Teachers equipped with a tripod camera w/ supplemental microphone and monitor
 - Interaction between in-person and virtual learners
 - Transitions
 - One way stairwells, hallways
 - Morning Break
 - Outdoor, supervised "mask-free" areas
 - Indoor, supervised socially distanced areas w/ masks





- Tue/Wed or Thur/Fri
 - Lunch
 - Optional Departure sign out at Front Desk of US
 - Limited Westview Dining
 - Ticket system
 - Groups eligible a ticket on a scheduled basis
 - First come, first serve
 - Evaluate system at end of Feb.
 - Supervised, socially distanced indoor/outdoor dining in New Upper School
 - Advisory/Meeting for Worship
 - Dedicated times in both Green/Gold and will include Distance Learners





- Tue/Wed or Thur/Fri
 - Afternoons
 - Academic Help Scheduled to Advisory locations
 - In-person & distance meetings
 - Affinity Groups and Clubs
 - Scheduled into socially distanced locations and virtual participants live-casting in
 - Supervised Study/Work
 - Socially distanced locations for quiet work
 - Socially distanced location for collaborative work requiring talking
 - Academic Support in development

 - Yoga and Dance continue in the daily schedule (2nd Semester)
 - Outside athletics approval through Steve Powers or Amanda Hill

Mask & Distancing

- All Community Members expected to abide by safety regulations
 - Social distancing of 6 feet
 - Wearing masks
- Teachers/Staff determine observance of proper social distancing behavior
- Egregious violations of safety protocols, or demonstration of unwillingness to abide by safety protocols will likely result in the student being removed from on-campus learning
- School Schedule, Facilities and Logistics will support safe practices and behavior

 - Managing cognitive load and emotional health


