

Notes:

1. Please note when morning and afternoon examinations begin and ensure that you are in School at least 30 minutes before that time in order to ensure that the Examinations may begin on time.
2. Students may not, under normal circumstances, enter the Examination Room *after* an Examination has begun nor leave an Examination *before* the scheduled conclusion time and until formally asked to do so.
3. Toilet breaks are not permitted during Examinations.
4. Food may not be brought into the Examination Room under any circumstances – water (still water only) may be brought into the Examination Room in a clear, plastic container which must remain on the floor next to the student's desk – noting, in particular, point 3 above.
5. All items of value, including any communications devices, must be deposited securely in lockers; they may *not* be brought into the Examination Room under any circumstances.
6. Students must bring an HB or 2B pencil to all multiple-choice questionnaire Examinations together with their own eraser.
7. It is students' own responsibility to provide sufficient batteries for their calculators – this is not a school responsibility and the School would not normally carry spare batteries for this purpose.
8. Any items used for writing in an examination must be brought in to the Examination Room in a clear plastic bag or container.
9. If a student's first language is *not* English s/he may use an approved translating dictionary for all non-language examinations but this dictionary must be checked and approved at least 24 hours prior to the first examination in which it is intended to be used and must then remain in the Examination Room.
10. All wrist watches must be removed in the Examination Room and placed on the floor next to the student's Examination Desk.
11. Students are *not* required to attend Home Group meetings on any of the days on which examinations occur but students *must* sign in when arriving at school and *must* sign out when leaving the School so that we always know how many people, and who, should be in the building.
