

FLORIDA BRIGHT FUTURES SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM:

Beginning in the fall 2021 semester, Bright Futures Florida Medallion Scholarship (BFFMS) students enrolled in an associate degree program at a Florida College System (FCS) institution will receive 100 percent of tuition and specific fees. Upon completing an associate degree, the student may use his or her award to pursue a baccalaureate degree and receive 75 % of tuition and specific fees.

Students will be evaluated based on official test scores from the FDOE repository. To ensure OSFA obtains official test scores:

- Ensure <u>demographics</u> on your test registration and high school transcript match;
- Request your official test scores be sent to one of Florida's 12 state universities when registering for the ACT®/SAT®.

- Become a <u>Compeer mentor (Peer to Peer)</u> earn hours of service and provide support to peers dealing with mental health issues. Contact Dr. Maria Clapp (Counseling).



SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY FOR JUNIORS/SENIORS

- Did you know that if you score **1330** on your SAT, you can qualify for a 100% paid scholarship to a Florida university or college?
- **The Academic Empowerment Agency & The Lean On Me Project** have collaborated to offer 10 juniors and seniors the opportunity to apply for this scholarship to prepare for the SAT/ACT.
- Juniors or seniors must have a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 to be eligible.
- All applicants must be planning to pursue an Associates, Bachelor's, or Technical degree from an accredited college or university on a full-time basis upon graduation or in the next 2 years.
- Scholarship awards will be based on:
- Successful completion of this application by the deadline (April 23, 2021)
- Demonstrated financial need
- A minimum 3.0 (unweighted) grade point average
- Recent High school report card or transcript
- A personal interview
- Semi-finalists will be selected and then be scheduled for a personal interview by the course instructor, Dr. Janjay Gehndyu.
- Candidates will be notified by April 29, 2021, for classes to begin on June 5th. All successful candidates and their parents will be required to sign a Learning Contract, indicating their commitment to completion of this program including the requirements to enroll in the SAT Test scheduled for August 28.
