

Físico

estrangulación | deteniendo a la víctima contra su voluntad | rompiendo artículos empujadas | mordidas | patadas/ golpes uso de arma | asesinato

Emocional

Aislamiento | insultando | humillación juegos mentales | minimiza o niega reacciones explosivas o críticas | controlar finanzas | falta de confianza | acecho amenazas de suicidio | amenazas de violencia física | amenazas de asesinato

Sexual

violación | forzar actos sexuales | sexo sin consentimiento | uso de armas durante el sexo | causar dolor durante sexo | sexo forzado que involucre a multiples parejas

Verbal

gritos | lenguaje obsceno o vulgar comentarios crueles e hirientes degradando a la víctima en público disminuyendo logros entrando en rabia hechar la culpa
