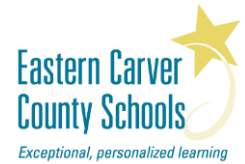


COVID-19 Guidelines for Spectators in

Eastern Carver County Facilities

Effective: Jan. 4, 2021



Capacities listed below are lower than what the Minnesota Department of Health is currently suggesting. This is due to the current 25% capacity guidance from Minnesota Department of Health.

Indoor Practices

Eastern Carver County Schools will continue to allow **no spectators in all our facilities for practices/rehearsals**. The one exception is for children under 5 participating in activities. They are allowed 1 parent at practice. Parents must maintain a 6 foot distance from one another.

Games, Meets & Performances

Gyms & Wrestling Room

Due to the 25% capacity limit in gyms and not being able to maintain 12 feet distance, **Eastern Carver County Schools is not able to allow spectators in our gyms at this time**. Allowing spectators would put us over the 25% capacity in most spaces.

One volunteer, staff or parent per team is allowed to view the game for live streaming/video recording purposes.

Auditorium

Limited to 25% capacity or 150, whichever is lower. Spectators must be seated at least 6 feet from other households

Chaska High School Auditorium– 148 spectators

Chanhassen High School Auditorium- 150 spectators

Dome

If using all 3 fields to play 1 game: 2 spectators per player are allowed. Capacity not to exceed 150. Spectators must maintain a 6 foot distance from other households.

If playing multiple games on different fields: **no spectators are allowed**. One volunteer, staff or parent per team is allowed to view the game for live streaming/video recording purposes.

Pool

No more than 26 spectators at a time. Must be seated at least 9 feet from other households

Tournaments

Tournaments using gym space are to adhere to the same guidelines as normal games, with no spectators.

However, an exception to this may be made by limiting the number of courts used in gym spaces with 2 or 3 courts. 1 court gyms are not allowed spectators under any circumstances. A plan for spectators must be discussed and approved by Eastern Carver County Facility Department.

Other Spaces/Uses

All indoor spaces are currently restricted to 25% capacity or 150 maximum, whichever is less. If you have reserved a space within Eastern Carver County Schools and have questions regarding capacity, please contact the facilities department at 112facilities@district112.org. The facility department will determine the capacity for a space based on current guidelines.
