APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE DISTRICT FACILITIES REPURPOSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE (Education Code §§ 17387 et seq.)

An independent demographic study was recently presented to and discussed by the Board of Trustees and highlights some of the challenges being faced by the District from declining enrollment. The California Education Code encourages community involvement to facilitate making the best possible judgments about the use of excess school facilities, and, to avoid community conflict and to help assure building use that is compatible with the community's needs and desires. To meet and address the Education Code requirements and guidance and to engage community stakeholders, the Board has established a District Facilities Repurposing Advisory Committee. The Advisory Committee will be comprised of at least 7 persons and not more than 11 persons and will include representatives from diverse community interests.

The District is soliciting applications from persons interested in serving on the Advisory Committee who represent the ethnic, age group, and socioeconomic composition of the district, as well as representatives of:

- (1) the business community (such as store owners, managers, or supervisors);
- (2) landowners or renters (with preference to be given to representatives of neighborhood associations); and
- (3) persons with expertise in environmental impact, legal contracts, building codes, and land use planning, including, but not limited to, knowledge of the zoning and other land use restrictions in the City of San José and County of Santa Clara.

The Committee is advisory only; all final decisions relating to District facilities will be made by the Board after consideration of the Advisory Committee input and recommendations. Pursuant to the Education Code, the Advisory Committee will review the projected school enrollment and other data as provided by the district to determine the amount of surplus space and real property, establish a priority list of use of surplus space and real property that will be acceptable to the community, cause to have circulated throughout the district a priority list of surplus space and real property and provide for hearings of community input to the committee on acceptable uses of space and real property, make a final determination of limits of tolerance of use of space and real property, and forward to the district governing board a report recommending uses of surplus space and real property. The Advisory Committee is expected to meet during the period from February – May 2021 (the meeting schedule and frequency will be developed with input from Advisory Committee members).
