Missing Assignments in Skyward and Teams

As we near the end of the semester, your student may have an opportunity to complete some of their missing work. Not all missing assignments can still be completed; if your student has missing work, please have them check with their teachers about which missing assignments can still be turned in and which ones cannot.

We have fielded a few questions about perceived discrepancies between missing assignments listed in Teams versus missing assignments listed in Skyward, and we want to clear up that potential confusion. Teams allows a student to click submit and thus inform the teacher they've turned in the assignment, but in some cases the student may have not actually submitted the assignment and only clicked the submission button. Skyward is where teachers enter scores and report those results to students and parents, so if Skyward still shows the assignment is missing, please trust Skyward.

If Skyward shows the assignment is missing and your student insists they've turned in the assignment to the teacher, please have your student confirm the syncing status of their One Drive, have them confirm the syncing status of their One Note, and submit a

help desk ticket through ftaccess@lwsd.org if the problem is not easily identifiable through syncing status. There have been instances where the student thought they submitted an assignment but the teacher never received it because the student's One Drive account wasn't syncing.

- Schedule change requests are open for submission as of 1/13/21 and due by the end of day 1/20/21. You will need to state the class(s) you are requesting to drop and what 3 options you would like to have in place for each class. Please see the attached document PDF download of available [Elective courses to choose from](#).

Reasons to submit a schedule change request are:

- You are a senior missing a graduation requirement.
- You have a "see counselor" or missing a period for fall semester.
- Incorrect level placement.
- Did not request this course (counselors will verify).
- Running start/WANIC student schedule conflicts with high school schedule.
- Counselors are not available to have individual meetings about schedule change requests during this busy registration period.
