Reconfirmation Meeting for January

Reconfirm how instruction (Return to Learn Plan) is going to be delivered during the 20/21 school year:

During this time frame, MDHHS continued to implement an order requiring grades 9-12 instruction to be conducted in a virtual remote format. This order extended through December 20. In-person learning resumed for grades Y5-8 on December 7. Y5-5th grade returned to 5-day in-person instruction and grades 6-8 returned to Hybrid instruction. Grades Y5-8 returned to 5-day in-person learning on January 4, and grades 9-12 returned to 4 days in-person instruction with Wednesday remote virtual instruction on January 4. Remote virtual learning options continue to operate grades Y5-12 for students and families choosing that option.
