

| Question  | Answer   |
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| How many electives should incoming 9th graders select per semester?   | All students are required to register for 7 credits and the number of electives may vary from student to student based on the course selection.  |
| Is Spanish considered an elective?  | No, Spanish counts as a World Language credit.   |
| Is PE a requirement?  | Yes, all students must take 3 PE classes/1.5 credits   |
| Do Occupational Ed/CTE classes count as Fine Art credits?   | Some classes meet both the Occupational Ed/CTE and Fine Art requirement and this is noted in the course description in the <a href="#">course catalog</a> .  |
| What is the requirement for honors classes?   | There is no grade requirement for honors courses. An honors class provides an opportunity for a student to examine a subject in more depth, both in content and analysis of subject matter. Honors classes challenge students to high levels of thinking and learning. We encourage students to make sure they are challenging themselves in subject areas they are interested in. |
| Does World History 1 qualify for the Social Studies Elective .5 credits?  | Yes.   |
| Can freshmen take AP Biology?   | AP Biology is available to grades 11 & 12 and students should have successfully completed high school Biology, strongly recommend Chemistry prior or concurrent.   |
| Are courses filled based on a first-come-first-take basis during the registration period (Jan 20 - 27)?                             | No—all course requests are considered equally.   |
| What grade do you need in both semesters of Geometry to move up to Algebra 2?   | The prerequisite for Algebra 2 is: Algebra 1 credit required, Geometry credit recommended  |
| How many languages are there that I can take?   | Students can take: French, Spanish or American Sign Language   |
| I want to take an online class before starting high school in math. How do I do this?   | Please contact your middle school counselor for information on how to take classes for high school credit.   |
| What exactly is Personalized Pathway Requirements and what are the options for it?  | Personalized Pathway Requirements (PPR) are related courses that lead to a specific post-high school career or educational outcome chosen by the student based on the student's interests and High School and Beyond Plan, that may include Career & Technical Education, and are intended to provide a focus for the student's learning.  |
| If you take a language class in 8th grade, such as Spanish 1, does that count as one of the credits for a language for high school? | Yes. Language and Math classes will be added to high school transcripts automatically. Students have the chance to have credits removed once they are in high school.  |
| Does club/select soccer qualify as a PE level activity, so we don't have to do PE during school hours?                              | No, outside activities do not count for PE credit.   |
