North Carolina Standard Professional 2 licenses must be renewed every five years with 8 units of renewal credit. Please be sure you know where you are in your renewal cycle and plan in advance how you will obtain your renewal credits.

Please submit <u>one</u> form per class/workshop, with a copy of the grade or certificate of completion/attendance, for each successfully completed class/workshop worth <u>1 CEU/renewal credit</u> (10 hours) or more. (Classes or workshops with less than 10 hours or 1 CEU/renewal credit should be submitted on your Cumulative Renewal Credit Form for Less Than 10 Hours/1 CEU Each.) Each renewal credit should be identified by a category. Some credits may fall into several categories.

Attached certificates should include the following information:

- Teacher Name
- Facilitating Agency
- Title of Course or Workshop
- Date Completed
- Renewal Credits OR Semester Hours (for college courses only)

Type of Credit	# of Credits
Content Credits (Academic)	
Teachers of grades K-12 and other licensed personnel must complete 3 renewal credits in	
their academic subject areas, including strategies to teach those subjects, during each five-	
year renewal cycle.	
Literacy Methods	
Teachers of grades K-8 must complete 3 literacy renewal credits which shall include	
evidence-based assessment, diagnosis, and intervention strategies for students not	
demonstrating reading proficiency. *Oral language, phonemic and phonological awareness,	
phonics, vocabulary, fluency, and comprehension shall be addressed in literacy-related	
activities leading to license renewal for elementary school license renewal.	
DTL Credit	
DCS requires teachers of grades K-12 to complete 2 digital teaching and learning renewal	
credits to improve student learning.	
General Credit	
Any credits approved by our local school system. These may be credits that do not fit into	
one of the other categories, OR "overage" in other categories may be classified as "general"	
to meet the required total of 8 credits in the 5 year renewal cycle.	
High Quality Staff Development	
Grounded in scientifically based research and focused on improving student academic	
achievement. NOT 1 day or short-term meetings and conferences, but rather activities that	□YES □ NO
are high-quality, sustained, intensive and classroom related focused. Regularly evaluated	
for their impact on increased teacher effectiveness and improved student achievement.	
School Administrator Credit	
School administrators must earn at least 3 renewal credits that align with the expectations of	
the NC School Executive Standards 2, 4, and 5 (focused on the school executive's role as	
Instructional, Human Resources, and Managerial Leader).
