



2021 COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS APPLICATION PROCESS FOR MAGNIFICAT FAMILIES

IMPORTANT DATES

- January - February** Complete School Counseling Requirement by meeting with your Magnificat Counselor
- February 1 - May 1 at 5:00 pm** Sign-up for an [OH|ID Account](#)
- February** Apply for Admission as a CCP Student to college(s) of choice; submit required materials for admission.
- February 1 - May 1 at 5:00 pm** Complete and submit funding application through [OH|ID Account](#). (Acceptance letter from college required.)
- Before May 15** Funding award notifications sent to parents. Students follow steps to register for CCP courses.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1 - LEARN MORE ABOUT COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS AND COMPLETE YOUR SCHOOL COUNSELING REQUIREMENT

- **Current state guidelines (during COVID-19) maintain that students must have a current, cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher to be eligible for CCP.**

STEP 2 - APPLY TO THE COLLEGE

- Check the websites of participating colleges in your area. All public and participating private colleges in the state are listed at <https://www.ohiohighered.org/ccp/resources>
- Complete the admissions application for CCP Students at the college(s) of your choice
- Request your Magnificat transcript to be submitted to the college by filling out this [Google Form](#).
- Once admitted to a college under College Credit Plus, the college will send your student an admission letter. (A copy of the admission letter must be uploaded to your College Credit Plus Funding Application. If you get an admission letter from more than one college, you must upload each college's admission letter. See Step 3.)

STEP 3 - SUBMIT YOUR COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS FUNDING APPLICATION- REQUIRED

- All parents are required to establish an [OH|ID Account](#) before they can apply for funding. You can create an account at any time. Summer classes are also an option. These sessions can start as early as May, so don't delay in establishing your [OH|ID Account](#). Here's a [step-by-step guide](#) on how to create an OH|ID account and Department of Education Profile
- Starting on February 1 until the deadline of May 1 at 5:00 pm, a parent/guardian must log-in to the OH|ID account and complete the Intent to Participate Section.
- In the OH|ID account:
 - Complete each section of the funding application
 - Upload requested documents
 - SUBMIT the application before the deadline of **May 1 at 5:00 pm!** (No exceptions and no extensions are available.)

STEP 4 - RECEIVE YOUR AWARD LETTER AND REGISTER FOR COLLEGE CLASSES

- You will receive your funding award notification within your College Credit Plus Funding Application located in your [OH|ID Account](#) before **May 15**.
- Once you receive your award notification, students can register for college courses.

STEP 5 - REGISTER FOR COLLEGE COURSES

- Students can follow registration steps outlined by the college in order to enroll in courses and obtain course materials. Advising appointments, additional forms, placement testing or standardized test scores, and orientation may be required by the college.
- Students should follow up with their Magnificat Counselor for any adjustments to their Magnificat Course Schedule
- Upon completion of College Credit Plus courses students must submit an official college transcript to Magnificat to finalize awarding of high school credits and grades.
