




# How to Add a Home Wi-Fi Printer to a Chromebook

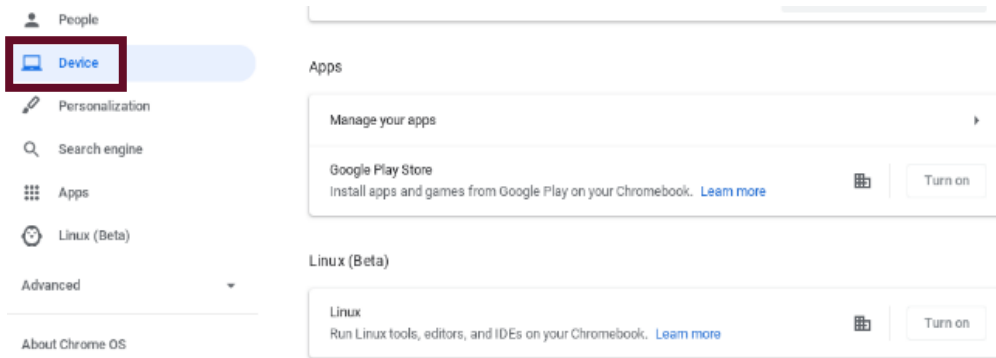
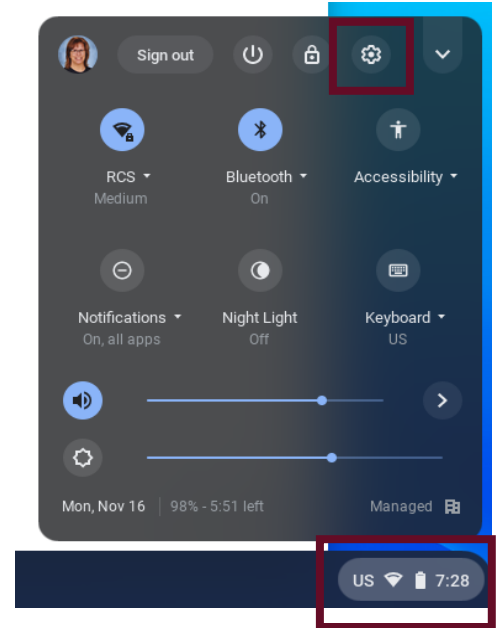
You can print from you Chromebook using most printers that connect to Wi-Fi or a wired network.

Currently Chromebooks don't support Bluetooth printing.

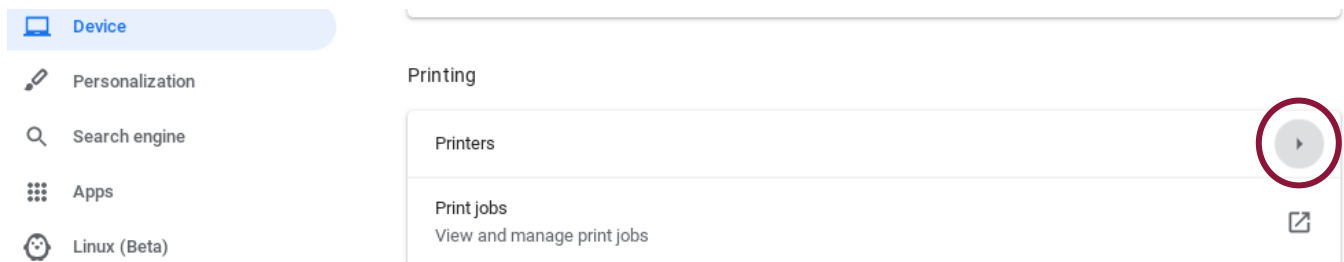
\* Please keep in mind that all home printers are different and you may need to consult your home printer Help Guide.

**NOTE:** Make sure your Chromebook and your Wi-Fi printer are on the same network and that the printer is powered on.

1. Sign in to your Chromebook.
2. In the lower right of the window, click on the Chrome **tool tray** and select the **time**.
3. Click on the **Settings**  icon.
4. On the left side of the Settings window, click on **Device**.
5. Scroll down the list to the bottom and choose **Advanced**.



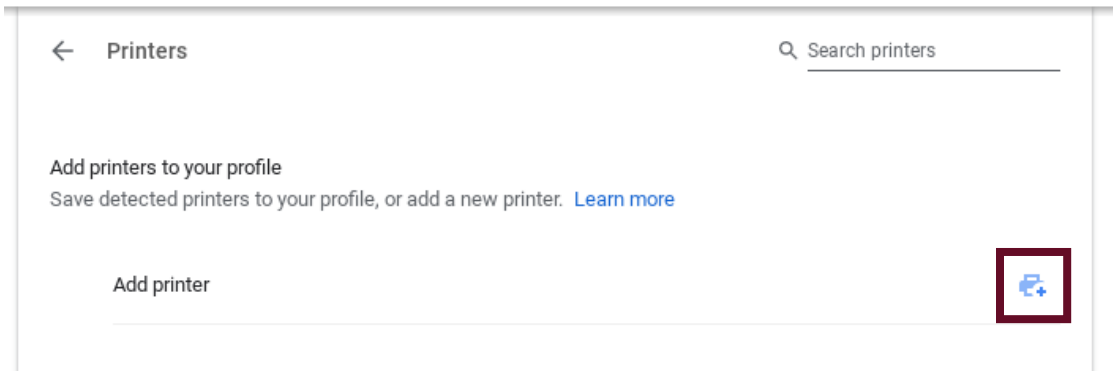
6. Scroll down to Printing and choose the **triangle** to the right of Printers.





# How to Add a Home Wi-Fi Printer to a Chromebook

- Click on the **blue printer +** icon to the right of **Add printer**.



- Now, you'll need some information from your Wi-Fi printer. The printer will have an IP address that will be listed under your printer Wi-Fi settings or when you print a status page. Consult your printer Help Guide on how to find this information or take a photo from the Wi-Fi Settings LCD screen on your printer.
- Enter a name for this printer so that you can easily find it in your printer list when you select **File>Print** or **Ctrl + p**.
- Enter the IP address that you found from step 8 in the **address** line and then click **Add**.

**TIP:** You can also use a USB cable to connect your printer to your Chromebook. When you use a cable, you'll see a notification. Follow any onscreen instructions. Your printer won't need to be connected to Wi-Fi if it is directly connected to your Chromebook.
