Bicycles on Campus

POLICY FOR THE USE OF BICYCLES ON MELHC SCHOOL GROUNDS

All staff have the privilege of cycling around the school campuses (no students are allowed to cycle) providing the following conditions are observed,

- Bicycles are brought to school at the owner's risk and the school accepts no responsibility for loss or damage.
- Bicycles must be roadworthy; brakes, tyres, etc. must be regularly checked by the user.
- Riders should ensure they have a full set of working lights and reflectors for evenings and on dark mornings.
- Cycling is NOT permitted on the grassed areas.
- Only one person should be riding the bicycle at any given time.
- When riding on paths, priority must be given to pedestrians.
- No cycling is permitted on pedestrian routes during break periods (cyclist should dismount)
- Carrying equipment which affects the ability to ride should not be undertaken.
- Cyclists should have full control of their bicycle at all times.
- Particular care must be exercised when cycling over speed humps/bumps/ramps as these put additional stress on the frame accidents can, and have happened by riding poorly maintained bicycles over these important road safety features at excessive speed.
- The school strongly recommends that a helmet is worn when cycling on all MELHC campuses.

Note:

Failure to comply with the regulations or safety conditions may result in the bicycle privilege being removed.
