Organizational Information:

The award is to recognize high school seniors who have outstanding academic achievement and who are interested in a teaching career. Awards are made to high school seniors who attend public high schools in San Joaquin County. This award is to be used at an accredited college or university.

Eligibility Factors:

1. High School senior graduating in current school year from a San Joaquin County public high school.
2. Proven academic ability with a GPA of 3.0 or better.
3. Autobiographical essay including reason for choosing a teaching career.
4. Demonstrated leadership qualities and abilities.
5. Citizenship qualities
6. Financial need.

Basis of Selection:

1. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. The selection committee will verify that all application components are complete.
2. Only 2021 application forms will be accepted.
3. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of academic achievement, school record, extracurricular activities in school and in the community, work experience and financial need.

Application Procedure:

1. Scholarship application and autobiographical essay and at least two letters of recommendation (one must be from a faculty member) to be submitted to the scholarship counselor in each school by February 19, 2021.
2. Application form, a transcript of grades with cumulative GPA, essay and letters of recommendation are to be submitted by the school to the contact, Helen Vignolo, Chairperson by Friday, February 26, 2021.
3. Scholarship recipients will be selected by Scholarship Foundation.
4. Scholarship recipients will be notified by the second week in April.
5. Scholarship recipients will be presented at the May meeting of the California Retired Teachers Association Division #20
6. Award will be sent to the college or university that the recipient will attend in the Fall semester.
7. If a recipient fails to enroll, the institution is instructed to return the award to the Scholarship Foundation.

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All items must be completed. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Attach a copy of:

- (1) Your official high school transcript
- (2) Two letters of recommendation (one from your academic teacher)
- (3) Autobiographical essay
