

**PARKLAND HIGH SCHOOL (PHS)
DRIVER EDUCATION- THEORY
SUMMER 2021**

NOTE: This is not for the Behind-the-Wheel Program. For more details about that program and how to register your child, please go to <https://driversed.cliu.org/index.php>.

Students who would like to complete the Driver Education- Theory course, which is a graduation requirement for all PHS students, during the summer months should review this packet. This program is available for the following students:

1. Current 9th grade students who wish to fulfill the graduation requirement during the summer months prior to starting 10th grade.
2. Current 10th or 11th grade students who need to fulfill the graduation requirement who did not take the course or who did not pass the course during their 10th grade year.
3. 10th, 11th, or 12th grade students who reside in the Parkland School District but attend another school (i.e. – private school, charter school, homeschool, etc.).

Students have two options to consider for completing this course during the summer: An online course through PHS or an online course through Carbon Lehigh Intermediate Unit #21 (CLIU #21). Only online options are available this summer. Details for each are provided below.

OPTION #1: PHS Online Driver Theory Course

The following provides information about the PHS Online Driver Theory Course:

REGISTRATION: Please click on the link listed in item #1 under “Final Instructions” at the end of this document.

DATES: M 6-14-21 – F 6-25-21

TIME: 9 AM – 12 PM

Students will log in to their Schoology accounts during these hours to participate in the course. The class will be comprised of live, online instruction with the teacher (Mrs. Andreoli), videos relating to course topics, and various online activities and assignments. Students will use their PHS issued Chromebooks to complete this course.

COST: \$175 per student

This course will cover the same material that is studied during the semester long course that is offered during the school year. It is offered at an accelerated pace for two weeks. As it is an online course, students will be responsible for completion of work through an online format. More specific information about what this will look like will be available to participants before the start of the course. This course must have a minimum of 14 students to run and will be capped at 50 students. Registration is on a first come, first serve basis.

Current PHS students who enroll will receive .25 PHS credit and a final grade, which will appear on the student’s transcript. All students, including non-PHS students, who take and successfully pass the course will receive a certificate of completion.

OPTION #2: Online Driver Theory Course through CLIU #21

The following provides information about the Online Driver Theory Course through CLIU #21:

In collaboration with the Edward Savioz Driving School, this 30-hour online course can be completed at your own pace from anywhere you are connected to the internet. The course is interactive, convenient, and easy to navigate. To register for this course, students and their families must do the following:

1. Go to <https://driversed.cliu.org/index.php>. This will take you to the CLIU’s Student Driver Education Program page.
2. Scroll down to “Online Driving Theory Instruction” and click on the hyperlink, “CLIU Keys to Driving.”

3. Follow the instructions to register and submit payment online for your son/daughter to sign-up for the online course.
4. Once registered, students will be able to access course content by going to:

If selecting this option, students and their families must make note of the following:

1. This course is not affiliated with Parkland High School. It is facilitated by the Edward Savioz Driver Training School (now called Keys to Drive).
2. Students and their families are responsible for completing the registration and for making payment to this program. Parkland High School is not responsible for completing these.
3. Students who choose this option must also complete our online registration to notify PHS of their intent to take the course through CLIU. Please click on the link listed in item #1 under "Final Instructions" at the end of this document.
4. **Also, as per Edward Savioz Driver Training School/Keys to Drive rules, students MUST be 15 years of age at the time of registration to complete this course. If students are not 15 years of age by August 20th, 2021, they will not be able to complete this option this summer.**

Upon successful completion of the online course, students will receive a certificate of completion. Students must then email a copy of this certificate to their PHS guidance counselor by Friday, August 20, 2021, to show proof of completion of the Driver Education- Theory course as this is a PHS graduation requirement. Students will not receive the .25 credit and will not receive a grade as the course is off-campus.

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Any student who wants to complete the Driver Education- Theory Course (through PHS OR through CLIU #21) must indicate their intent to do so by completing the Parkland High School- Registration Form- Driver Education- Theory Course- Summer 2021: <https://forms.gle/2HpiggSdNVtGGC9v6>
2. For those who plan to take the PHS Online course, you will complete your registration through this form and remit payment (\$175 made payable to Parkland School District by check or money order) to:

The deadline to complete registration and submit payment for the PHS course is Friday, June 4, 2021.

3. For those who plan to take the CLIU #21 course, you will simply indicate this on the Google Form. You must then complete registration and submit payment to the CLIU #21 course as stated in Option #2 (above). **The deadline to submit intent to complete the CLIU #21 course is Friday, June 25, 2021.**
