This weekend we will be celebrating the Feast of St. Francis De Sales, January 24, 2021, the Patronal Feast of the Oblates, Bishop and Doctor of the Church. His feast day is an Obligatory Memorial in the Oblate Calendar. Since this year the commemoration falls on the 3rd Sunday of Ordinary time, Bishop Burbidge has granted permission for OLGC to celebrate the Memorial of St. Francis de Sales at all weekend Masses. This is being done following the provision which allows for the pastoral good of the faithful, that observances "that are agreeable to the devotion of the faithful," be permitted to be observed on Sundays of Ordinary Time. Our readings for this weekend are: First Reading - Proverbs 16: 16-23, 32; Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 34; Second Reading – James 3: 13-18; Gospel – Matthew 5: 13-19. We originally planned to have a special reception, but due to COVID-19, we have canceled that and look forward to the time where we can all gather safely.



COVID-19 VACCINE NEWS – Many of you probably already know that as of January 11, adults age 75 and older can call the Fairfax County Health Department's vaccine hotline at 703-324-7404 (Mon-Fri, 9 am to 7 pm, Sat and Sun, 9:30 am to 5 pm) to register for an appointment to receive the shot. However, reports are that's it's very difficult to get through. Not to worry! You can answer a guestionnaire online and will be contacted to set up an appointment. Here's the direct link: www.fairfaxcounty.gov/health/novel -coronavirus/covid-19-vaccine-appointment-questionnaire. THEY WANT YOUR STUFF - Skip the garbage and give unused possessions to charities that target donations to specific causes. The following organizations will be a helpful resource to those of you who are working at downsizing or just getting better organized at the start of a new year.

 <u>Medical Supplies</u>: Project Cure and Advocates for World Health accept medical gear and unused supplies for worldwide use: *projectcure.org; awhealth.org*. Med-Eq connects you with charities seeking supplies and equipment, mostly for overseas use: <u>med-eq.org</u>.
<u>Computers</u>: A laptop you mail to Globetops will go to someone in need in the U.S. or elsewhere; <u>globetops.com</u>. The National Cristina Foundation links you with charities in your neighborhood for your tech: <u>cristina.org</u>. <u>Hearing Aids:</u> The Starkey Hearing Foundation and the Hearing Aid Project both distribute recycled devices: <u>starkeyhearingfoundation.org</u>; <u>hearingaiddonations.org</u>. Your local Lions Club may also accept hearing aids: <u>lionsclubs.org</u>.

Appliances: Many Habitat for Humanity ReStores, which sell construction supplies and household goods, will pick up large appliances. You can also drop off small appliances and other items: *habitat.org.* Thanks AARP Magazine) **NEW FRAUD WEBSITE** – The FTC has a new website for reporting fraud. ReportFraud.ftc.gov is where consumers can easily report fraud and other consumer issues. And it's quicker than ever. Once filed, your report will be shared with over 3,000 law enforcers across the country. While you're on the site, you can poke around its consumer sentinel data bank to see data on specific fraudulent operators targeting your city or town. The site is also in Spanish at <u>ReportFraude.ftc.gov</u>. The FTC report fraud team can also be reached by phone at 1-877-FTC-HELP (382 -4357.)
