### Prepare

- ✓ Verify the 4-year plan created in Advisory has you on track to meet graduation and college entrance requirements
- ✓ Practice for SAT/ACT exams using Naviance Test Prep; send PSAT scores from College Board to Khan Academy for customized SAT practice and ACT Academy for customized ACT practice
- ✓ Take SAT/ACT exam
- ✓ Participate in relevant enrichment opportunities (search for them in Naviance)

### Search

Identify colleges that fit your goals, interests, needs, using:

- ✓ SuperMatch college search survey in Naviance
- ✓ College Board's Big Future College Search survey
- ✓ *The College Finder* (Antonoff) or [www.collegexpress.com/lists](http://www.collegexpress.com/lists)
- ✓ College Maps in Naviance
- ✓ College Resources Page (bottom of Naviance welcome page) in Naviance, for help with the college search and applications, college essays, financial aid and scholarships, and gap year programs

### Investigate

Learn more about colleges:

- ✓ Colleges' websites: mission statement, virtual tour, gen. ed./core reqs, depts., academic advising, campus life (housing, food, sports, clubs, Greek life), undergraduate research, career center and internships, study abroad, community service
- ✓ Counselor Notes from rep's visit to Paly in Naviance college profile
- ✓ % out-of-state students, residential vs. commuter campus, ethnic diversity (consult College Board college profile)
- ✓ Academic climate and social culture (consult *The Fiske Guide to College* and *The Insider's Guide to College*, as well as [niche.com](http://niche.com) and [youiversitytv.com](http://youiversitytv.com))

Learn about NAIA and NCAA Division 1 and 2 course, GPA, and test requirements; register with Eligibility Center if considering collegiate athletics.

### Focus

Ask for letters of recommendation from 2 academic teachers of core subjects (preferably from junior year); learn about how to do so in the Viking Guide.

Track college specs; in Naviance, use College Tracking chart in Document Resources folder:

- ✓ Course requirements: # of years of subjects/courses, college-entrance tests, kind and # of teacher recommendations (information found on Naviance, College Board, Common App, or college websites)
- ✓ Selectivity (national stats from College Board and Paly stats from Naviance School Statistics and scattergram graphs): admit rate %, mid-range test scores, and average GPA from previous year's admitted students
- ✓ Financial aid requirements and deadlines

### Experience

- ✓ Attend college fairs and local receptions/info sessions; see tips handout in the Document Resources folder in Naviance
- ✓ Meet with college representatives visiting Paly; see calendar on: <https://paly.net/counseling-wellness/college-and-career-center>
- ✓ Visit colleges (see planning presentation in Document Resources library in Naviance); consult list of Paly grads at the colleges you're considering (in the C&CC)
- ✓ Interview with Admissions office or local alums: <https://bigfuture.collegeboard.org/get-in/interviews/college-interviews-the-basics> (and tips in Document Resources library in Naviance)

## SENIORS

### Build

- ✓ Develop a balanced list of 8-10 colleges: at least 2 likely schools, perhaps 2 reaches, but mostly targets. See "How Can I Determine if a College is a Likely, Target, or Reach" in the Building a College List section of the *Viking Guide*. Create a solid foundation.
- ✓ Track application requirements and deadlines, as well as financial aid deadlines: use College Tracking Chart for Seniors in Document Resources folder in Naviance
- ✓ Meet and review list with your College Advisor

### Apply

- ✓ Map out all writing topics: main essays and any supplementary writing (i.e. college-specific questions)
- ✓ Invite (and assign) recommenders in the Common App (and/or other applications) by the Paly deadline(s)
- ✓ Complete applications online; consult tip sheets in Document Resources library in Naviance in the following folders:
  - Common App
  - CSU and UC
  - Community College

### Submit:

- ✓ Cover Sheet assignment in Advisory Schoology course by Paly deadline(s)
- ✓ If the college doesn't accept online teacher recommendations or your teachers prefer to mail recommendations, give stamped, addressed business-size envelope with Teacher Evaluation form to your teachers

### Order:

- ✓ Official Test Score Report from College Board and/or ACT to be sent to colleges (and NCAA) if applicable
- ✓ Transcripts to non-Common App colleges, from Parchment, if applicable, by Paly deadlines: <https://paly.net/our-school/transcripts> (and NCAA, if applicable)

### Complete

File the FAFSA and any other financial aid forms (e.g. CSS profile) by colleges' deadlines: <https://www.paly.net/campus-life/college-career-center/financial-aid-scholarships>

### Decide

Attend "Admitted Student" events

### Act

- ✓ Submit Intent to Enroll by May 1
- ✓ Sign up for housing, if applicable
- ✓ Accept or decline offers of financial aid
- ✓ Sign up for Orientation
- ✓ Take math & English Placement Tests, if required
- ✓ Order final transcript via Parchment to be sent to college (and NCAA, if applicable)

### Reflect

Send thank-yous to teachers/TAs and others who've helped or supported you through the college search and application process

### Participate

- ✓ Visit campus resources: tutoring services, health center, advising, career center, other support services
- ✓ Join clubs and organizations, do community service, pursue internship opportunities
- ✓ Check out Events calendar and participate in activities

### Live

- ✓ Manage your time, exercise, eat, and sleep!
- ✓ Stay in touch with family and friends

## PALY DEADLINES: 2021-2022

The Paly deadline indicates the latest date to **order your transcripts online, assign recommenders in the Common App, and submit your Cover Sheet for College Applications.**

If your application is due to the college by:	Order your transcripts online, assign recommenders in the Common App, and turn in school forms to the Guidance Office by:
October 15	September 13, Monday
November 1	September 27, Monday
November 15	October 11, Monday
November 30 / December 1	October 27, Wednesday
January 1	November 8, Monday
January 10	November 19, Friday
January 15	November 29, Monday
February 15	January 13, Thursday
March 1	January 31, Monday

If you miss these deadlines, we will not be able to send Paly's part of your application by the college due date. This will jeopardize your application.
