# 2019 ANNUAL PERFORMANCE REPORT (APR)

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- **APR will not provide points or percentage of points**
  - For instance, last year BSD earned 97.3% of possible points
- **APR data will be represented visually**
  - Report will feature colored bar charts indicating status levels:
    - “Floor / Approaching / On Track / Target”
  - Allows districts to focus on growth
  - Formulas/Calculations have not changed
- **Most standards will have BSD scores & state averages**

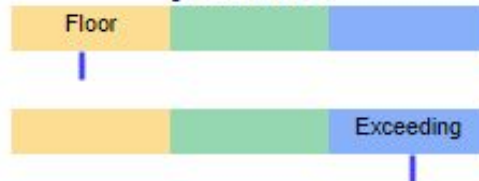

- There will be no Social Studies data this year due to field test in 2019

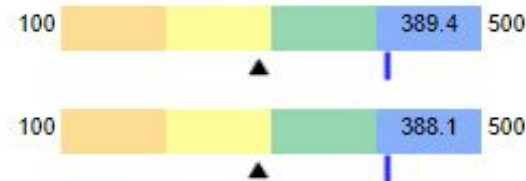
Are individual students making achievement gains over time?



- This metric measures individual student growth on Grades 4-8 MAP tests
- Students must have at least two valid MAP scores
- Floor / On Track / Exceeding are in relation to the Missouri Mean

Are all students achieving at high levels at this point in time?

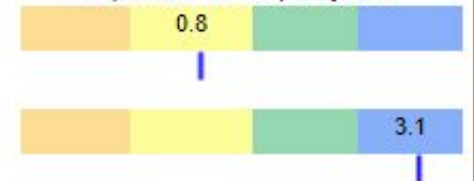

- Student achievement is based on 3-year average of aggregate MPI scores (MAP Performance Index)
- BSD is in the "Target" area for both ELA and Math and well above the state average

- This metric looks at district-wide MAP improvement
- Uses a rolling average of the last three years
- Progress is measured by comparing BSD to state measures

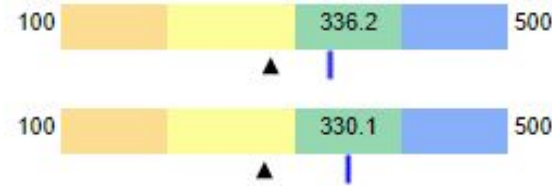

Are all students achieving at high levels at this point in time?

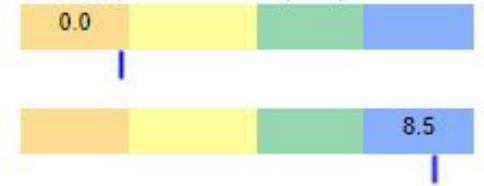

- District wide progress over time



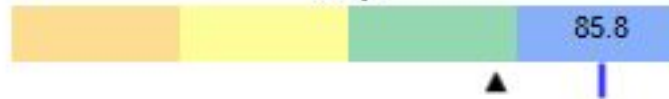

### 3. College and Career Readiness (CCR)

1-3 CCR Assessments

- Standardized Test Scores (i.e. ACT)
- District Average of Test Scores
- Percentage of students taking standardized tests

What percentage of graduates are college or career-ready?



- Class of 2019 Composite ACT Score Average = 23.4
  - Missouri Average = 19.9
- 68% of 2019 BSD Graduates met/exceeded state standard for ACT (22+)
- 100% students participated in standardized testing

Is the school district or charter making progress towards all students being college or career-ready?



- Progress is measured by rolling average
- Difficult to demonstrate progress with high performance



4 Advanced Placement

Calculated using a 3-year average

Is the school district or charter making progress towards all students earning advance or vocational credit?



Progress is calculated using a rolling average over last three years



### 5-6 Postsecondary Placement

- Percentage of students entering post-secondary education or military
- Percentage of students who are working in area of training (i.e., tech school)

What percentage of graduates were employed, in the military or seeking further education six months after graduation?



- Uses three-year rolling average
- Class of 2019 = 90.6%

Is the school district or charter making progress towards post-secondary placement for all students?



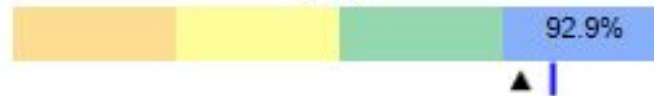
Progress is calculated using a rolling average over last three years



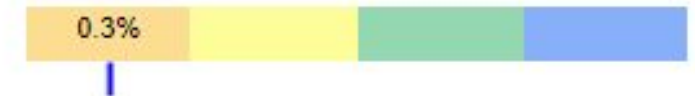


#### 4. Attendance

What percentage of students were present 90% of the time?



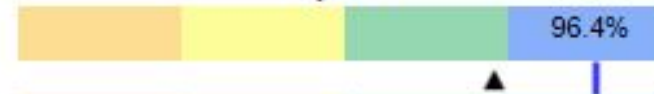
Is student attendance improving over time?

Five Year Graduation Rate



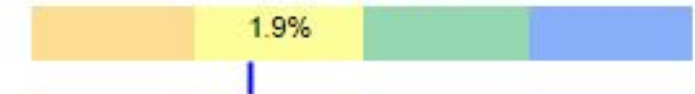
Six Year Graduation Rate
