Elementary Chemistry 5 Credit Hours through WSU

Northridge High School CHEM 1110

Fundamentals of inorganic chemistry and introduction to organic chemistry.

This is a yearlong course.

What at the university is done in 12 weeks,
we do over a year it is a much slower pace.

The first course in a two-semester sequence designed primarily for students of nursing, engineering technology, other fields of science and health professions, and those who require no more than one year of chemistry for general requirements.

13 Chapters, 12 Labs, online homework, tests through Chi Tester,
lecture and activities in class.

Students with good GPA and self-motivation are good candidates for this class.

**We cover the same topics as general high school chemistry,
but you get university and high school credit.**

This is the class that most universities give AP students credit for if they pass the AP exam. However, Medical schools will accept this grade where they do not accept AP scores because there is no grade attached.

It is cheap. Total class cost is about \$150 for the 5 credit hours of university credit, which at the university would cost \$1546.35 for the 2019-2020 classes.

This class stays on a student's university transcript so a student must be motivated to do the work and keep their grades up. They must also be willing to take initiative to come in and get help when they do not understand something.

Students must be admitted to WSU by the first day of class and then registered for the class by the end of the first week of school.

That means that the tuition and fees need to be paid then.
