

16-19 Tuition Fund Statement

Overarching principles

- Southam College has been allocated £829 in extra support for 16-19 education due to the impact of the COVID 19 Pandemic
- This extra money will be spent to support students with their November GCSE maths re-sit exams based on the eligibility criteria below.

Background to the 16-19 Tuition fund

The funding was set up in 2020 to provide and support small group tuition for 16 to 19 students in English, maths, and other courses where learning has been disrupted. For example, vocational courses where assessment has been deferred because of lockdown. Although the actual tuition does not need to be for GCSE English or maths, the students supported all need to be those who had not achieved grade 5 or above in at least one of those subjects at this level by age 16. All supported students must be on a 16 to 19 study programme.

The funding should be used to support the tuition activity above and beyond the programmes of education already planned for 2020 to 2021.

How Southam College intends to use the 16-19 tuition fund

Type of provision: Catch up tuition towards students doing Maths GCSE re-take exams in November 2020. A blend of in school catch up during October ½ term holidays and remote support through PetXi

Size of groups: Students will be taught in small groups of 4 students set based on initial assessment of their progress in GCSE maths

Eligibility: Students are eligible based on their enrolment into 6th form without having prior attainment at GCSE maths grade 4. In the event of oversubscription, priority will be given to disadvantaged students in receipt of FSM or the Sixth Form bursary
