In recent years, the College has invested significantly in enhancing the Sixth Form experience: the Sixth Form Centre, Sixth Form Study Hall and the Careers Department have been united in the heart of the original building to striking effect. All the traditional A Level subjects are offered and the most able students will go on to achieve top grades in three, four or, just occasionally, five A Levels. At the same time, we offer a range of vocational BTEC Subjects, including Business, Hospitality and Sport, ensuring all needs and abilities are catered for.

The average class size in Year 13 is 11 students. This enables teachers to know each student's needs and to tailor their teaching and support accordingly. Support extends outside normal lessons, with teachers always willing to provide extra tuition and help when needed. The quality of A Level and BTEC teaching at Campbell College is excellent.

Pathways

At Campbell we are focused on the overall journey of each individual, from the moment they enter the College to beyond their departure. Our goal is to ensure each student maximises his opportunities and makes the right choices for his future. Of our 2020 Year 14 leavers 84% progressed to undergraduate university degrees covering a wide variety of courses from Medicine, Law and Engineering to Film, Ancient History and Wildlife Conservation; the breadth of our student choices is one of our core strengths at Campbell thanks to an exceptional Careers Advisory Service.
