

Paul Miquelon Memorial Scholarship

Annual **\$3000** Award (renewed for up to 4 years) / **\$12,000** Total Award

Mr. Paul M. Miquelon was an active member of the Brentwood and Brentwood High School communities for several decades and served on the Brentwood School Board and was President for a number of years. One of his great joys in that role was reading the names at graduation and handing out diplomas to proud Seniors. All three of his children are Brentwood High School graduates and were active in athletics. He was also an avid high school sports fan and was known to attend a variety of sporting events, whether his children were involved or not. He was also a fixture on the football field as a member of the "Chain Gang". He impacted the lives of many students and their families and was often serving behind the scenes quietly. Upon his passing, the number of people that reached out and expressed gratitude for his life was truly impressive. He left a tremendous legacy and truly believed in making a difference in the lives of others.

Mr. Miquelon came from humble roots on a family farm in Iowa and was one of seven children. When his work brought him to St. Louis, he planted deep roots in Brentwood and committed to the community. Family always came first. He coached little league sports, was active in his church, and was very involved in raising his three children with his wife Penny. Their home was a haven for neighborhood children and all were welcome there. Mr. Miquelon was known for his **kindness, integrity, work ethic, humility, and volunteering in the community**. The Miquelon family has established the **Paul Miquelon Memorial Scholarship** in his name and this award will go to the student that best exemplifies his legacy and all that Paul stood for and lived for. The award is for **\$3000 cash per year, up to 4 years - \$12,000 total**. This scholarship will be awarded each year to the most deserving Brentwood High School Senior each year. It is renewed each year with proof of remaining in good standing at their university. Each year a student will be named and in a few years, there will be four with a scholarship, simultaneously. It is hopeful that these students will become a community.

Eligibility requirements:

- 1) A completed application, including academic resume, essay, and letter(s) of recommendation, returned to Ms. Laura Brown by **April 1st, 2021**. The winner will be named by the end of the Spring semester.
- 2) Commitment to academics and plans to attend an accredited 2-year or 4-year college / university or career or vocational program.
- 3) A solid academic High School record (B average minimum).
- 4) Involvement in extracurricular activities.
- 5) Demonstrated a strong work ethic beyond school.
- 6) A history of helping others, being active in the community.
- 7) Solid moral character and impeccable integrity.
