Items of Business:

2. **Digital Citizenship/Safety/Positive Behaviors Report**
 - School has strong firewall, issue - home filters different. Kids know how to work around them to access games/apps. on school issued ipads. Causing difficulty in class. Students not doing work/paying attention in school.
 - Net smarts K-2 (assembly had to be rescheduled), Interland through Microsoft for grades 3-6.
 - Discussed best way to deliver training to parents: Batch of emails sent each day for a week focusing on digital citizenship, bullying, internet safety, child abuse. Online poll/survey.
 - Ask teachers their concerns and what they feel parents need to know.
 - We will discuss setting a time for the survey at next meeting in February.
 - Sanford Harmony, This months lesson on diversity and inclusion. How are we different and the same.
 - Fire drills are scheduled to resume in March.

3. **School Quarantine Plan Review/Update**
 - Each grade came up with their own plan.
 - Mask to mask contact - parents notified, student no longer required to quarantine as numbers show students are not contracting it.
 - Non-mask to non-mask contact - students still quarantine.
 - Quarantines also being assessed on a case by case basis.

4. **Review Land Trust Budget for 2020-2021 –**
on target, mostly salaries/benefits/webcams for teachers
 - a. **InfiniD**
 - b. **Technology that needs to be updated around the school**
 - Around \$33,000 left in TSSA to go towards -projectors, apple tv's, ipad pens, voice enhancers, wear and tear on student devices.
 - Add technology on next years goals.
