Dear Wolves,

This week students wrap up first semester and their grades will start anew on Monday for second semester. With every fresh start, we should remind ourselves of the actions that led to past successes and decide what we will do differently in the future to improve. Often when I speak with students about strategies for school success, I remind them of the importance of attendance and attentiveness. Consistent attendance, even in a remote setting, remains highly predictive of student success, and with our limited synchronous instruction and block schedules, missed days can have even more of an impact. Please take the necessary steps to minimize missed days and remember that healthy habits such as sleep, exercise and stress management can ensure students consistently show up to school ready to learn.

Consistent attentiveness in class also leads to success. We understand the difficulty at times of paying attention in this virtual setting but minimizing distractions and remaining present throughout the class is of utmost importance. Each class period through their learning targets, teachers also share with students what they need to know or be able to do. If in each period, students made sure they learned that content, skill or concept and asked questions or followed up if they did not understand, it would minimize the need to cram for tests or finals. It will also prevent students from falling behind in a cumulative curriculum, where previous knowledge is foundational to understanding new content.

I understand that it's not always that simple but combining consistent attendance and attentiveness with other learning strategies such as goal setting and effective organization will lead to more success with less stress. Please reflect on what you will continue to do and do differently during the second semester. Perhaps even set goals and develop action plans to implement new habits and monitor progress over time.

College Board Drops SAT Subject Test and SAT Optional Essay

College Board announced several changes to their suite of SAT assessments. SAT Subject Tests (the one-hour subject-specific tests previously recommended by a handful of colleges) have been eliminated for all U.S. students. The SAT Essay will also be discontinued. College Board is also working on a digital version of the SAT which will be described in greater detail in April. What do these changes mean for Eastlake students? Students can contact College Board to adjust existing registrations and request refunds as needed for Subject Tests and/or the optional essay portion. Juniors should continue to register and prepare for a spring SAT or ACT to maximize options while colleges determine their Class of 2022 testing requirements.
