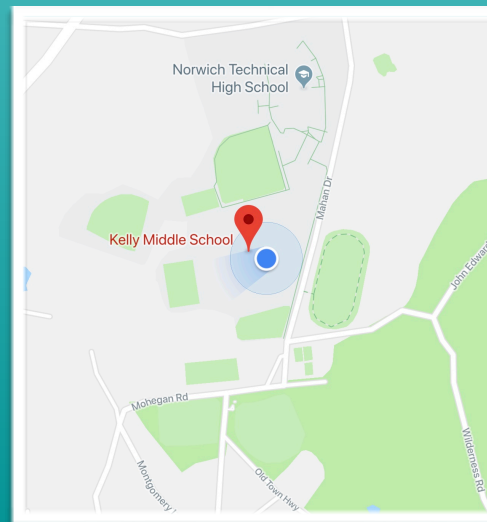

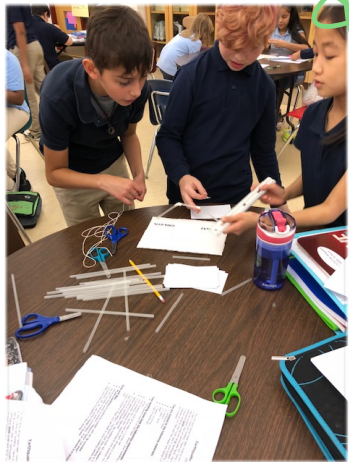
KELLY STEAM
