Student grades can be viewed by logging in to <u>Skyward Family Access</u> and selecting the Grading tile. YES Prep Family Portal

The YES Prep Family Portal is now live! The portal will allow you to access your child's grades, attendance, assignments, behavior, etc. in one place and communicate with your child's teachers and campus leaders in your preferred language as the Family Portal has simultaneous translation in 60+ languages. There is also a mobile app for Apple and Android to make it even easier to use the Family Portal to support your child's learning.

You must use <u>your email address on file in Skyward</u> to access the Family Portal. This ensures that your student's data remains safe and secure. Please visit <u>Family Portal Help</u> TODAY to set up your account. If you experience any issues, simply email the Family Portal Team at <u>TechStrategy@yesprep.org</u>. If you did not receive the email, please reach out to your campus registrar to be sure you have an email on file in Skyward.

Please note that the Family Portal is not available for YES Prep Northbrook families, as these partnership campuses operate through the Spring Branch ISD student information system. In addition, the Family Portal will not be used at the elementary campuses until the 21-22 school year
