COVID-19 Prevention and Response Health and Safety Protocols

Overview

On March 16, 2020 site-based classroom instruction was suspended by order of the San Francisco County Public Health Officer in all Public and Private Schools in San Francisco County to help mitigate the spread of COVID-19 in the local community. All schools were forced to develop remote instruction for students, including all schools in the San Francisco Unified School District. Under the guidance of the San Francisco County Public Health Officer, San Francisco County School Guidelines (30 Point Plan) and School Site Specific Protection Plans (SSSPPs) have been developed for all San Francisco Unified School District Schools, Programs and offices. These SSSPP's meet all requirements of and serve as the Cal/OSHA COVID Prevention Plan (CPP), and along with the COVID-19 School Guidance Checklist serve as the Lycée Français de San Francisco – Richmond's COVID-19 Safety Plan (CSP) for In-person Instruction. All District SSSPPs are consolidated and posted on the Lycée Français de San Francisco Website, and made available to staff, students and families as required.
